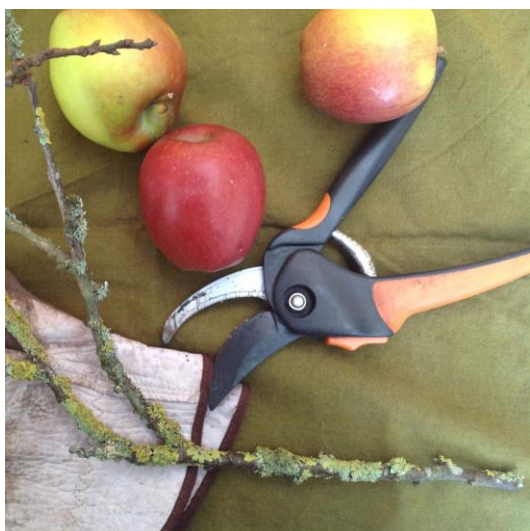

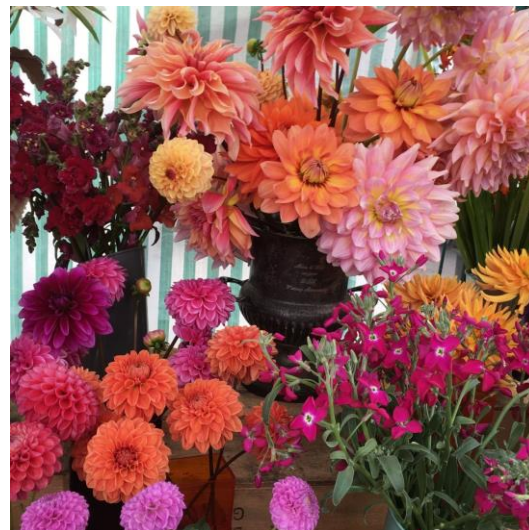
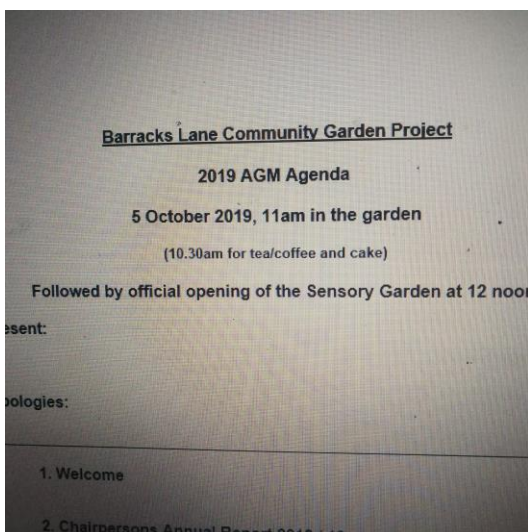
Volunteer apple presser wanted!
